



# FASHION FINDS...

This month we feature ladies casual and outdoor wear, courtesy of MAFCA and Melanie G.Whittington of the Almost Heaven A's. We begin with page 1, and will follow up with the conclusion next month.

#### Ladies Casual and Outdoor Wear in the Model A Era

The fun of dressing for the Model A era doesn't always have to involve evening gowns with lots of jewelry, matching shoes and purse. We sometimes forget there are many options to consider when dressing for the era. This article is going to focus on what to wear when outdoors. Our mothers, grandmothers and ggrandmothers were tending the garden, hiking, camping and a variety of other activities which took them outside. Think back to the people in your family who were around in 1928-31. If you are lucky enough to have pictures, they are a great reference for your research on what to wear with your Model A.

Ladies who lived out in the country would spend a considerable amount of time outside hanging up laundry and working in the garden. These activities were a necessity and kept their family fed and clothed. A cotton housedress and apron are a Figure 1:National Bellas Hess, Spring and staple to start a wardrobe which Summer 1931



focuses on comfort and utility. These dresses could also be worn on a picnic or a trip into town. Work-weight hosiery were commonly worn with these house dresses. These stockings would be heavier cotton, wool or silk, worn with a low-heeled leather shoe.

A dress I never knew existed in our era is the house frock with a divided skirt. Though we rarely hear about it, it was common enough to be included in the catalogues of the day, such as Sears, Montgomery Ward and National Bellas

Hess. These dresses used a skirt with a seam in the middle to turn them into wide-legged pants. This gave the feminine

look of a skirt, but the practicality of a pair of trousers. These dresses were made of printed cotton. The ad says, "for use around the house or to the market". This shows these were considered appropriate to be worn outside of the home.

Another option is bib overalls with a mannish long-sleeved, button up shirt with oxford style shoes, boots or even barefoot. This may have been reserved for very rural areas and not necessarily seen if you 'went into town', but it is still an option to wear while enjoying your Model A. This is also a great alternative for children and young girls with a short-sleeved cotton shirt. A dark wash blue jean fabric is what we usually think of, but they came in lighter blue, dark blue with white stripes, white (for painters) and various other colors. The fabric was usually heavy-duty denim or a duck/canvas to withstand the rigors of working or playing outside.

### The Tech Corner

#### Jim's Tech Tips

"Infrared (IR) Thermometer Guns"

These little IR thermometer guns are amazing. I use mine to check coolant temperature at the outlet of the engine, look for cool spots on radiators, check tire sidewall temperatures, and to see if all of my brake drums are at about the same temperature after a hard brake (to confirm even braking action at each wheel).


If you are going to get a reliable, consistent, and reproducible reading with these guns, you need to understand a bit about how they work. When you aim the gun at something and press the button to read the temperature, the gun reports to you the average temperature of everything within its "Field of View".

#### Field of View

The meter's field of view is 12:1, meaning that if the meter is 12 inches from the target, the diameter of the object under test must be at least 1 inch. Other distances are shown in the diagram below. Make sure that the target is larger than the unit's spot size. The smaller the target, the

closer you should be to it. When accuracy is critical, make sure the target is at least twice as large as the spot size.

If you want to read the temperature with a spot circle diameter of  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (a very handy size), you must hold the gun 6" from the object. I have seen some guys hold the gun several feet from a radiator hose and not understand why the reading is so low; their 3" diameter spot circle includes a lot of cool air on either side of the radiator hose. Get in the habit of holding the gun up close to the object for the best readings.

Some guns have a laser pointer built in that helps you see where the temperature readings are being taken. The laser does not read the temperature, it just helps you see where the reading is from. You have to visualize the spot circle size, depending on how far the gun is from the object.

I hope this helps you get more out of your IR thermometer. If you don't have one, they are handy to have around the shop and on the road.

# MAFFI Newsletter Minute December, 2022


