



On our final day, we visited the Looney House, the oldest house in Alabama, dated to 1820. We then visited Janney Furnace where you visited the sight of a Confederate pig iron furnace that was destroyed by Union forces. A Memorial Museum included the names of locals killed.

From there we had lunch, followed by a visit to Anniston Natural History Museum and Berman Arts Museum. Another wonderful tour from our Central Alabama friends.






