



# The Tech Corner

### Restoring #1595 – Part I

It was supposed to be just another dinner with a few Model A friends in April, 2013. Two Southside A's Model A club members, Dick Carne, Ray Besch and our wives, would get together from time to time to talk shop about various Model A's and our past experiences with these wonderful cars. At the time, I knew little of A400 Model A's except that Mike Shotwell, National President of the A400 Group, owned one and was also a member of our Model A club. And Jack Miller, another club member also owned a former national award winning A400.

At our dinner, Dick, always looking for another project, was excited about a lead he received about an A400 that he believed might be a great car to invest in and restore, as they had a far higher value than other models A's. They also had a wonderful versatility as a convertible and an enclosed sedan with roll up windows. His enthusiasm transferred over to me, and I was intrigued and excited with the possibility of this new world. The car Dick was talking about, #1595, was in a storage shed in Colorado.

The history of the car interested me. The owners, Mr. Tim Snyder and his father, had owned the car for over 25 years. Prior to their ownership, the car had been purchased by a gentleman in Illinois, who had bought the car from "some Indians in Arizona." Tim said that "this old topless car arrived filled with Indians from a local reservation." The sale was made on the spot for \$50. The car was running well and had little rust, most likely due to the dry desert climate. It eventually made its way to Florida, where Tim Snyder purchased it. It had been partly disassembled by this point and was no longer running. The Snyder's decided to keep the car as a future project and it followed him in a move to Colorado, where it stayed for twenty five years or more. As many projects go with the passing of time, the Snyder's dream was never completed.

A few swaps of photos and phone calls ended with Ray Besch and I traveling at the end of May, 2013 to see the old project Tim had started with his father so many years before. The story of the trip to the car is as fascinating as the eventual restoration. Our travel directions from Tim took us to Alamosa, CO, population 8,700, where we ended up in a gravel parking lot outside a Sears store. We didn't see any houses nearby and considered the fact that we might be lost. A phone call to Tim assured us that the Sears destination was correct. He was the manager. But we also found out the car wasn't there, it was 50 miles away up in the mountains. So off we trekked following Tim. Our path took us northwest off state highway 17 onto a dirt road leading into a canyon. After passing over two smaller wooden bridges, one which made me a bit faint

> as I was in my heavy F150, with both of us strongly considering the possibility that we might end up in the stream below. We took the challenge and ended up in the very rear of the canyon at Tim's retreat. We were then shown to a small metal Butler shed and shown the car, situated in a back corner, with parts around in boxes, inside and under the car.





What we found was a very straight car which had been pieced together with most of the hard to find parts, like top irons, ashtrays and regulators intact. We both considered this car a diamond in the rough. The negotiation was quickly made and #1595 was now my car. One more problem confronted us. I planned to have a professional car transporter pick the car up, however the mining road and the questionable bridges prohibited this plan. Tim quickly solved the problem by agreeing to have the car picked up at the Sears parking lot. Ray and I packed all of the loose valuable parts into my truck and crossed our fingers that the rest of the car would arrive safely. Our gamble paid off. In early June, the carrier arrived with its Russianspeaking drivers and it was placed in our storage facility in Peachtree City, GA. The next adventure was about to begin.


