


12th Night Celebration

If you have your Model A registered in the program, take a look at your odometer reading. If you are close to reaching the next award level (2,000 miles, 5,000 miles and each 5,000 mile interval thereafter) consider taking her out for a drive and earn your next award level. If your Model A is not registered in this program, consider registering and begin accumulating miles for your first award level (2,000 miles). 
